ASSOCIATION RULES & REGULATIONS

ARTICLE I: DWELLINGS

- a) All units will be considered single family dwellings.
- b) No unit shall be occupied permanently by more than four persons. A stay of more than 60 days will be considered permanent. (As amended on November 19, 2009).
- c) Unit owners must provide to the Executive Board a set of keys to their unit. These keys will only be used in the event of any emergency.
- d) No unit owner may conduct a business from their unit without full knowledge and approval of the Executive Board.
- e) Washers and dryers are only to be operated between the hours of 7:30 AM and 11:00 PM.
- f) No cooking is permitted on patios or balconies at any time.
- g) In order to cut down on cooking odors, unit owners are asked to use kitchen exhaust fans whenever possible.
- h) No clothing or bedding material may be hung on patios or balconies.
- i) Construction equipment and power tools may only be used between the hours of 8:00 AM and 7:30 PM.
- j) No Pets Allowed ***
- k) Unit owners are required to cover all windows with light colored verticals or draperies (white, off-white or grey).

ARTICLE II: COMMON AREAS

- a) No soliciting
- b) No littering
- c) No personal items are to be left in the hallways
- d) Utility closet in each tower are for Association use only. No personal items may be left in the utility closet at any time.
- e) Only patio furniture is permitted on patios/balconies.
- f) Only SMALL POTTED FLOWERS are permitted on patios/balconies.
- g) No unit owner may place carpeting or tiling on patios/balconies without approval of the Executive Board.
- h) No motorcycles allowed.
- i) No auto repairs or washing cars is permitted at any time.
- j) The Executive Board believes that the following areas may be hazardous to children:
 - 1. Retention Basins
 - 2. Pool area (when not in use)
 - 3. Creek
 - 4. Driveways
 - 5. Bridge over creek

The safest place for children to play is on the field next to the pool/clubhouse.

ARTICLE III: PARKING

- a) Each unit is assigned one permanent parking spot.
- b) Unit owners with more than one car must park additional car(s) in spot marked "Visitor".
- c) Head-in parking only.
- d) No car should take up more than one spot.
- e) No unit owner may give their assigned spot to someone else.
- f) 5 MPH speed limit.
- g) No trucks are permitted during overnight hours.
- h) Illegally parked cars may be towed at owner's expense.

ARTICLE IV: CLUBHOUSE

- a) The clubhouse is for the exclusive use of unit owners and their guests.
- b) Reserving the use of the clubhouse will be on a first come basis.
- c) Any unit owners wishing to reserve the clubhouse must check availability with the Executive Board. If available, unit owner must give a minimum of 2 weeks written notice to the Board. A notice must then be placed on the clubhouse bulletin board.
- d) From time to time, the clubhouse will be used by the residents Association as a whole. The Board will notify unit owners in advance of any intended use. The clubhouse will be unavailable for reservations on Memorial Day, July 4th and Labor Day.
- e) Unit owners using the clubhouse are responsible for keeping the clubhouse clean and neat. Any damage caused by a resident or their guests will be the sole responsibility of the resident.

- f) No functions may be carried on in the clubhouse during pool hours.
- g) No one is permitted to enter the pool deck through the clubhouse sliding doors.
- h) The clubhouse is protected by a security system; therefore, no one may enter the clubhouse between the hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM, except with advance permission from the Board.

ARTICLE V: POOL RULES

- a) Pool hours are 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM daily.
- b) No food or glass containers in the pool area.
- c) No diving.
- d) No running in pool area.
- e) No tubes or floats in pool.
- f) All children under 12 yrs. old must be supervised by a responsible adult.
- g) No child in diapers will be permitted in the pool
- h) Pool chairs may not be removed from the pool area.
- i) Pool chairs and tables are on a first come basis. No reserving of tables and chairs is permitted.
- j) Bare feet and wet bathing suits are prohibited in the clubhouse.
- k) Residents will enter the clubhouse through the front door only. Sliding doors will be closed at all times.
- 1) All guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times. Exceptions may be made with advance Board approval.
- m) Smoking is permitted in designated area only.
