 - ✓ Water infiltration on the 14th floor We have hired a firm to design a water mitigation plan,
- ✓ **Storm drain upgrade** The storm drain issue that caused floods in unit 114 has been resolved by a plumbing contractor. But we have a few more units to protect.
- ✓ Trash Compactor Jeff Rath has researched companies that can replace our 50 year old compactor when we need it. Please drag out your crystal balls and let us know when that will be.

The above list reflects emergencies or urgent issues, but is hardly an exhaustive list of repairs or improvements that have to be made. Council, Management and Maintenance staff are compiling a list which will be prioritized and considered in the budget process.
